#### **Procedure**

This procedure must be carried out on both front brake calipers.

- 1 Raise the car.
- 2 Remove the upper brake caliper retaining bolt.

3 Fit and tighten a new bolt to torque.

#### Tightening torque 117 Nm (87 lbf ft)

- 4 Remove the lower brake caliper retaining bolt.
- 5 Fit and tighten a new bolt to torque.

6 Apply Mercasol spray to the bolts.
