Mobile telephones and communications radio equipment without a separate external aerial propagate radio waves which are reflected inside the cabin.

- The field of electromagnetic waves inside the cabin may be injurious to health.
- The field of electromagnetic waves may also cause interference with the car's electrical system.

Procedure

Saab therefore recommends connecting a mobile telephone or communications radio equipment to an external aerial at all times.

In addition, an external aerial ensures better transmission and reception performance as well as a longer range.

From the viewpoint of road safety, it is advisable to stop the car at a suitable place when using a mobile telephone.
