

Condensation in air ducts



Cars concerned

Saab 900 Cabriolet.

Background

In hot and damp climates and under certain driving conditions, water may drip from the air ducts onto the floor under the dashboard. The cause of this is the transport of dehumidified air from the evaporator which condences on the colder surfaces of the air duct.

Materials

47 58 330 Insulation, left-hand side LHD

47 58 355 Insulation, right-hand side LHD

47 59 163 Insulation, left-hand side RHD

47 59 403 Insulation, right-hand side RHD

47 59 254 Wire mesh screen, only cars before chassis number T7001459


47 58 439 Seal, evaporator cover, only cars before chassis number T7001459

Action


- 1 Remove the glove box.
- 2 Remove the front floor air ducts.
- 3 Remove the lower dashboard section on the driver side.
- 4 Remove the air duct.

The following measures from point 5 to point 11 inclusive need not be carried out on cars after chassis number T7001459. An evaporator of new design which prevents the transport of dehumidified air has subsequently been introduced.


5 Remove the protective cover.




- 6 Unscrew the antifrost thermostat nut and, where appropriate, remove the fan control.
- 7 Remove the evaporator cover and collect the seal.




8 Insert the wire mesh screen between the heating and ventilation unit and evaporator housing, taking care not to damage the wire mesh.




9 Fit the new evaporator cover seal. To seal more effectively, it is slightly larger than the earlier one. Check its fit to ensure that no leakage occurs.




10 Fit the evaporator cover and, where appropriate, tha fan control. Apply silicon paste between the fan control and evaporator.



- 11 Screw the nut on the antifrost thermostat and fit the proective cover.
- 12 Remove the protective paper from the insulation.
- 13 Position the insulation and glue it in place on the air ducts.

- 14 Fit the insulated air ducts in place on both sides.
- 15 Check that no water leakage occurs when the air conditioning is turned on at full power.
- 16 Fit the lower dashboard section on the driver side back in place.
- 17 Fit the amplifier, if the car is so equipped, and refit the glove box.
