

Base solid paints with clear enamel

Saab 9-3 3D/5D and CV from M98

Background

Saab will successively move away from using ordinary solid paints and start using base solid paints with clear enamel. There is a very real risk of mixing up these colour systems when refinishing the car. Therefore, cars with a base solid paint finish are marked with a special label.

Metallic paint systems are not affected.

Colour codes are not affected.

Parts required

Current colours:

Imola red, colour code 240

Ambassador blue, colour code 198

11/3/01 1 Black, colour code 170

Note that Cirrus White, colour code 153, and Monte Carlo Yellow, colour code 231, will remain as normal solid paint.


Touching up

Never mix the colour systems as there are differences in finish and ageing characteristics.

Never apply clear enamel to normal one-coat solid paint (not quality-approved by Saab Automobile AB).

Spray and enamel applicators can be used as usual for smaller repairs.

Marking



Once all the cars in production are painted with base solid paint, the text **BASE SOLID** will be added to the normal colour code and tyre pressure label.
